

# Moving Forward!!!



Good news! The CDC has relaxed their recommendations. Vaccinated worshippers can sit as close to each other as they wish. We have a plan to accommodate all of you. We are changing the layout of the Sanctuary beginning May 30<sup>th</sup> to accommodate this change while at the same time accommodating those who are not vaccinated or who are vaccinated and choose to continue to social distance.

One side of the main floor of the sanctuary (13 pews) will be available, without social distancing, for those who are fully vaccinated. We will **not** be checking your vaccination papers! This will be on an honor system. We will trust that, if you sit in the section without social distancing, you are fully vaccinated.

For those who are not fully vaccinated and their families, we will have the other side of the main floor, the balcony, and one pew in the choir loft set up with social distancing of 6'. So, if you are not vaccinated, or you have children or other family members who you plan to sit with

who are not vaccinated, you can sit in one of these 10 pews.

We do ask that those who are vaccinated please wear your mask while in the sanctuary, especially when going to or leaving your seat, out of respect and concern for those who are not yet vaccinated.

We will also set up the Mission and Fellowship Center so that the service happening in the Sanctuary can be shown on the screen, offering yet another socially distanced area.

In addition, the outdoor service will be moved to 8:30 am because of the warming weather. So, we ask that those attending the 8:30 service in the Sanctuary to please park in the back section closest to Jackson Terrace, or in the Clover Community Center parking Lot so that those attending the parking lot service can park close to the Mission and Fellowship Center.

We hope these changes will make Sunday worship more accessible to everyone. We hope to see you in church someday soon.
